Petitions were received and read from M.D. Baldwin and Jeremiah Cunningham asking for saloon license in that part of Douglas County North of Kansas River.

On Motion License was granted. M.D. Baldwin and Jeremiah Cunningham for one year from the 1<sup>st</sup> July 1865 amount of license tax fixed at \$100. Each.

Board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.

Board met pursuant to adjournment. Full board present.

Presented affidavits stating that in the year 1863 he had no personal property subject to taxation, and that he had been charged on the tax rolls of Douglas County for that year with amount of \$15000. which tax was added in to the amount of tax on real estate taxed for said year and sold in 1864 for said taxes and asks that he be permitted to redeem said real estate deducting the amount of said personal property tax. On Motion Ordered that the Treasurer <sup>be instructed</sup> to allow R. S. Stevens a redeem seven and one half acres of land sold for taxes of 1863 on his property in the city of Lawrence deducting the amount of personal property tax and penalty on same.

The following preamble and order was read and adopted.

Whereas the following Territory to wit: Commencing at a point where the Eastern line of Jefferson County touches the line of Douglas County on the Kansas River thence North to the North line of Township 12 thence West along said line of Township 12 to the Kansas river - was by the act of the Legislature of Kansas of 1861 attached to and made a part of Douglas County, and whereas there is not sufficient Territory in said tract to form a new municipal Township it is therefore ordered that said Territory be and the same is hereby attached to the Township of Watamora.

On Motion Ordered

That the County Assessor obtain a copy of the last assessment of the real estate in that portion of Douglas County north of the Kansas river.

Ordered that the several County officers be instructed to deposit each night all record and other books of value to the County in the vault prepared for that purpose in the Treasurer's Office.
