Board met pursuant to adjournment. All Board present

Kenny Hargrave presented a petition for license as Drum Shop Keeper. There not being sufficient evidence that the petition contained the names of a majority of the house holders in said Township it was on motion ordered that the petition be not granted.

The report of the reviewers on the petition of C. H. Prew and others for the review of a road the route of which had become uncertain was read and on motion said road was ordered to be re-established according to the Reviewers report filed in the Clerk's Office Oct 2 1865

On motion ordered that the Clerk be instructed to the several Justices of the Peace in the County to immediately report the amount of fines collected by them and pay over to the Treasurer any money so collected.

The following resolution was offered and adopted
Whereas the expenses of keeping the Poor of the County is largely on the increase and the present mode of providing for Paupers is very expensive and Whereas the Board believe that the Poor of the County could be much more cheaply and comfortably provided for in a County Poor House and whereas a sufficient amount cannot be appropriated without submitting the question of such appropriation to the Electors of the County It is therefore ordered that the question of levying a tax of one mill on the Dollar of the taxable property of the County for the purpose of purchasing a farm and erecting suitable buildings thereon for a County Asylum be submitted to the qualified
