

Election of Douglas County at the general Election to be held on the 17th day of November AD. One Thousand Eight Hundred and sixty five. It was further ordered that the Clerk be instructed to publish a Notice of the submission of said question in the Baldwin City Observer the Leocompton New Era, Kansas State Journal and Kansas Tribune.

A petition was presented signed by Asa Darwall and others asking that a change be made in the Lawrence and Fort Scott road and it appearing to the Board that legal publication had been made of said petition it was ordered that Messrs. P. Kennedy, J. W. Shepherd and William Means be appointed to view the route of the proposed change, to meet at the house of Asa Darwall on the 27th day of November AD. 1865 at 2 o'clock P.M.
