The Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment Present Commissioners Gleason & Dickson and P.R. Brooks County Clerk.

On motion an appropriation of seven hundred dollars was made for repairing the Stanton Bridge road (or called) to be placed in the hands of the Trustee of Wakarusa Township to be expended as soon as practicable.

On motion the sum of \$50. was allowed to E. Diebner on account of Road being located through his land in Clinton Township. After some discussion in regard to roads and bridges the Board adjourned until tomorrow at 12 O'clock PM.

Tuesday December 5 1865

The Board met pursuant to adjournment Present Messrs Gleason and Dickson and the County Clerk.

C.E. Ramus presented Plans and specifications for building a bridge across the Wakarusa River near Stewart's Crossing.

Mr Ramus proposed to the Board to furnish the Labor and build the bridge according to plans and specifications submitted, for \$600. the County to furnish all lumber and materials.

On motion the proposition was accepted and a contract entered into with Mr Ramus to build and complete the bridge on or before the first day of March 1866.

On motion an appropriation of \$600. was made for building said bridge and also the sum of \$600. for furnishing materials for said bridge.

On motion the above appropriations were ordered to be placed in the hands of the County Clerk to be paid out on proper Vouchers.
