Bissell and Eldred Wood be appointed to meet on the 18th day of January 1866 to view said proposed road - place of meeting, house of J. Shields.

Ordered that the jailers residence now occupied as County Office and the furniture and Books in said Office be insured in the Hartford Insurance Company to the amount of Twenty five Hundred Dollars on the building and One thousand Dollars on books and furniture.
