

W. M. Nace Overseer of Poor of Leocompton Township presented a petition for an additional appropriation for support of Poor in said Township. On motion the sum of Two Hundred and fifty Dollars was appropriated for that purpose.

A petition was presented signed by David Hubbard and others asking that the Lawrence and Marion Road be reviewed and reestablished. Representing that the Point and route of said road had become uncertain.

On motion it was ordered that Clark Tafft, Asa Dutton and J. M. Shephard be appointed to meet at the house of J. M. Shephard on the 25th day of January 1866 at 9 o'clock A.M. for the purpose of reviewing said road.

A petition was presented signed by E. Poole and others asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the Board that the Petitioners had made legal publication of said petition it was ordered that Clark Tafft, Asa Dutton and J. M. Shephard be appointed to meet at the house of J. M. Shephard on the 25th day of January 1866 to view said proposed road as required by law.

On motion the sum of \$50 was ordered to be paid to Mrs O. Hemington on account of location of Lawrence and Paola road being located through her land.

Edward Chapman presented a petition setting forth that he had paid taxes on the rolls of 1865 excessive and illegal to the amount of \$7.26 and it appearing that the facts were correctly set forth in said Petition it was ordered that said amount be refunded.

William Krutchfield Overseer of Poor in Wascamow Township asked for a further appropriation of One Hundred and fifty Dollars for support of poor in said Township for present fiscal year. On motion the sum of \$150. was appropriated in accordance with the petition.

Pocot Pike agent of the Kansas Stage Company presented a Statement setting forth that said Company had paid excessive and illegal tax to the amount of \$18.20 for the year 1865 and it appearing to the Board that the facts were correctly set forth in said Statement it was ordered that the said sum of \$18.20 be refunded to said Stage Company.

The Bond of D. S. McIntosh appointed by the Governor as Justice of the Peace in Leocompton Township to fill a vacancy was presented for approval. The securities on said bond having filed a notice that they would not be held the Board refused to approve the bond.

William Krutchfield trustee of Wascamow Township presented a report of appropriations placed in his hands to be expended on roads in said Township. With Vouchers showing how said appropriations had been expended leaving a balance in his hands unexpended of \$285.20 as follows
