The board of commissioners met pursuant to adjournment.

Present Messrs Gleason, Hase Campbell and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

Geo. S. Stearns having offered to sell the County the North West quarter of section twenty (20) Township thirteen (13) Range twenty (20) for the sum of Twenty two Hundred Dollars, five hundred Dollars to be paid down and Seventeen Hundred Dollars in one year with interest at the rate of seven per cent. It was voted to accept the offer. W. Shannon Esq Agent of Mr Stearns presented a deed for said land which was examined and accepted and on motion ordered that a warrant be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of said Geo. S. Stearns for \$2200.00. Also a warrant for \$1,819.00 payable on the first day of February 1867 being the amount of the final payment on said land with interest included.
