Ordered that the valuation of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 9, T. 15, R. 20 be raised \$2 per acre. That the E. 1/2 of Lot 48 Mass St. in the City of Lawrence be reduced \$300. That Lot 90 on Rhode Island St. be raised \$500. That Lot 54 Massachusetts St. be reduced \$500. That Lot 111 N.W. St. be reduced \$500.

On motion ordered that the tax on all Town Lots in the Town of Leecompton belonging to Lane University be abated.

Ordered that the valuation of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 14 T. 15, R. 18 be reduced \$2 per acre. That the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 14 T. 15, R. 18 be reduced \$4 per acre. That the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 11, T. 15, R. 18 be reduced \$1 per acre. That the E. 1/2 of Sec. 12 T. 15, R. 18 be reduced \$1.50 per acre. That the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 12 T. 15, R. 18 be reduced .50 per acre. That the E. 1/2 of Sec. 13 T. 15, R. 18 be reduced \$1 per acre. That Lots 6 & 7 Levee in the City of Lawrence be reduced \$500.
