

A petition was presented and read signed by W. H. Dunsmuir and seventy others asking that the question of issuing the bonds of the County to the amount of \$50,000, for the purpose of building three bridges across the Wakarusa and improving the roads leading thence.

On motion it was ordered that a special election be called to be held on the 28th day of July A.D. 1866 to submit the question of issuing \$50,000. in Bonds of the County for the purpose of building three bridges across the Wakarusa Creek and improving the roads leading thence at the following points viz. One Bridge on the Lawrence and Emporia road near Bloomington One Bridge at the Hutchinson crossing and one bridge at Stewart's crossing so called and if the whole amount of the proceeds of said bonds shall not be required on said bridges and roads then the balance to be expended on such other bridges across the Wakarusa as the Commissioners may determine.

On motion ordered that the notice of Special Election be published in the Kansas Tribune, State Journal and Leocompton New Era.

Bill of John Spurr for rent of Court room and County Offices \$2.00. was presented and allowed. Also bill of A. Storm & Co. Money advanced for safe \$56.65 was allowed.

On motion ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of the Board be appointed a Committee to receive list and cancel all county orders Bonds and coupons which the County Treasurer may wish to turn over to the Board and report at the next meeting.

On motion the Treasurer was requested to present to the Board at their adjourned meeting on the 1st day of August a full report of the financial condition of the County including report of receipts and expenditures since last report showing also all liabilities and assets as far as possible.

On motion the Board adjourned until the 1st day of August.
