

Tuesday Sept 4 1866 9 o'clock A.M.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present Commissioners Gleason, Waco and Sears and Paul O. Brooks County Clerk.

The following preamble and order was offered read and on motion adopted.

Whereas the superstructure of the Stewart Crossing bridge recently erected by the County has been found defective in its construction and that the bridge is liable at any time to fall it is therefore ordered by the Board that the clerk be instructed to advertise for sealed proposals for placing said bridge in a safe condition and thorough repair according to specifications to be procured from some competent Engineer.

A petition was read signed by H. S. Commine and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein being on the line between Douglas and Johnson Counties and it appearing to the Board that legal publication had been made of said petition it was ordered that Wm. M. Givley, John Conger and Barkley Thomas be appointed as viewers of said road on the part of Douglas County to meet at the house of H. S. Commine on the 27th day of Sept 1866 at ten o'clock A.M.

On motion ordered that an appropriation of One hundred and seventy five Dollars be made for support of Poor in LeCompton Township for the year 1866 payable to Overseer of Poor of said Township.

On motion the tax on Personal property assessed to T. Hoopes for the year 1865 was stated upon evidence to the Board that he had no personal property subject to taxation for that year.
