The Board met pursuant to adjournment present Messrs Gleason, Nace and the County Clerk.

F. Fuller presented a petition asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing that legal publication of the petition had been made it was ordered that Wm. Winchey, Ambrose Randall and Robert Wilson be appointed to view the route of said proposed road to meet at the Windmill of Wilder and Palm on the 15th day of October 1866 at 10 O'clock A.M.

A petition was presented and read signed by Charles Schwarz and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and legal publication of the petition having been made it was ordered that James H. Kelley, Theodore Gliddens and Henry Brown be appointed to view the route of the proposed road to meet at the house of Charles Schwarz on the 20th day of October A.D. 1866 at 10 O'clock A.M.

A report from the viewers of a proposed road petitioned for by Sam. Deunman and others was presented and read. On motion ordered that the road be established according to the report of the viewers and the Clerk instructed to notify the Trustee of Wapamoa Township to have said road opened for public travel.

The viewers appointed to view a proposed road petitioned for by John Kayler reported in favor of the location of the road. On motion ordered that the road be established according to the report of the viewers. The viewers reported damages claimed by Lewis Estes and George Buckner to the amount of \$75, which on motion was allowed.
