Made application to the Board for license to keep a ferry across the
 Kansas river at Eldora On motion Ordered that license be granted
 to said Schlifer for one year from the 1st day of August 1866 with
 rates of toll as follows One horse vehicle thirty cents, two horse vehicle
 fifty cents, each additional team or yoke of cattle twenty five cents
 each horse and rider twenty five cents Led or drove stock each ten
 cents Hogs and sheep each five cents footman ten cents each, and
 double foregoing rates from nine and a half O'clock P.M. to five O'clock
 A.M.

 which was received and on motion accepted and ordered to be
 placed on file.

The petition of Sylvester Reed and others for a road
 filed April 2 1866 and laid over temporarily was taken up and

 were appointed to view the route of said proposed road to
 meet for that purpose at the house of S. M. Reynolds on the
 8th day of November A.D. 1866
