The Board then proceeded to examine a proposal for building the Stewart Crossing bridge there being but one the contract was awarded to Geo. M. Howell for the sum of \$2250.

A petition was presented signed by A. M. Whendow and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the board that legal publication of said petition had been made it was ordered that Asa Dutton Charles Wesson and W. B. Kennedy be appointed to view the route of said road to meet at the house of A. M. Whendow on the 22nd day of November 1866 at ten O'clock.
