

with proof of notice as required by law

On motion ordered that H. Le Enas H. F. Pirell and O. A. Houscow be appointed to view the premises and report to the Board as required by law.

On application of H. Gritchfield Overseer of Poor of Hiram Township an Appropriation of \$100 was made for support of poor in said Township for the year ending April 1 1867

The report of the viewers appointed to view the route of a road petitioned for by Sylvester Enell and others was read and on motion the report was adopted and the road established and ordered opened in accordance with the field notes and plat accompanying report

A petition was presented signed by B. Pebles and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing that legal notice and publication had been made of the petition it was ordered that H. H. Dwyer Geo. W. Enes and Joseph Savage be appointed to meet at the house of Robt. Pebles on the 20th day of January 1867 at ten o'clock a.m. to view the route of said road and report as required by law.

The report of the viewers appointed to view the route of a road petitioned for by Charles Schwan and others was read and on motion the report was adopted and the road established in accordance with the field notes forming a part of said report.

A petition was presented signed by S. C. Russell and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with evidence of legal publication. On motion D. G. Peabody Saml. Reynolds and Henry Brown were appointed to view the route of said proposed road to meet at the house of S. C. Russell on the 5th day of February AD 1867 at ten o'clock a.m.

Henry Disten and others presented a petition asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and the board having evidence that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that John Panning William Brass and Tho^s. Oliver be and are hereby appointed to meet with the County Surveyor on the 30th day of January AD 1867 at ten o'clock a.m. at the house of Henry Disten to view the proposed road.

A petition was presented signed by J. P. Whitney and others asking for the location of a road at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication. On motion ordered that W. H. H. Whitney Morgan Crankhite and Jas. W. Evans were appointed to view the route of said road to meet at the house of W. H. H. Whitney in North Lawrence on the 22nd day of January 1867 at ten o'clock a.m.

A petition was presented signed by R. C. Tasker and others asking for the location of a road at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication as required by
