

Laurens Kansas January 10 1867

The Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
Full Board and Clerk present.

The report of the Viewers appointed
to view the route of a road petitioned for by F. Fuller and others
was read and on motion adopted and the road established in
accordance with the field notes and plat accompanying said
report and the Clerk directed to notify the proper authorities to open
said road for public travel.

The Board proceeded to select a list
of persons to serve as Grand and petit jurors for the ensuing
year a list of which was certified and filed in the Clerk's office.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment. Full Board and
Clerk present.

A communication from the Board of Trustees of the
Town of North Laurens in regard to the apportionment of property
in said town was read and on motion laid over until the next
meeting of the Board.

A petition was presented signed by J. F. Fancett and
others asking that a road be located and established at certain points
named therein with proof of legal notice and publication. On motion
Amos Walton J. D. Smith and J. D. Wood were appointed to meet with
the County Surveyor at the house of J. F. Fancett on the 12th day of
February at 10 O'clock A.M. to view the route of said road.

A petition
was presented signed by Edw. Pools and fifty one others asking for the
vacation of a part of the Laurens and Marion road (so called) with
proof of legal notice and publication. On motion James H. Kelley
John Young and E. H. Vanhook were appointed to meet with the
County Surveyor at the house of E. Pools in Marion Township on the
26th day of February 1867 at 10 O'clock A.M. to view the route of
the road petitioned to be vacated.
