

Galveston Rail Road Company, and issue the bonds of the County therefor upon the following conditions to wit: said bonds payable 30 years after date bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum from delivery to be issued to said Rail Road Company upon completion and full operation of twenty four miles of Rail Road tracks from Lawrence Douglas County via Baldwin City. provided that no greater amount of Bonds shall be issued than the amount of stocks issued by said Company to the County of Douglas, and further provided that said Company shall complete and equip 24 miles of said rail road tracks before the first day of January A.D. 1868 and also further provided that the condition of the above is with the express understanding and agreement that the said Company shall relinquish all claims for the bonds heretofore voted to wit: on the 12th day of September A.D. 1865. Yes or No - Polls to be opened at 9 o'clock am and closed at 7 o'clock P.M.

On motion the Clerk was directed to publish the notice of said election in the several weekly papers published in the County also the Kansas Farmer.

The Bond of Eugene L. Akin County Attorney was examined and approved.

On motion ordered that the sum of \$15.00 be abated from the amount of funeral property assessed of H. L. Ains in Waxman Township.

On motion the action of the Board taken on the 12th inst rejecting the report of the viewers of the road petitioned for by S. H. Kelligass and others was reconsidered and the report was laid over until February 7th 1867.

A petition was presented from citizens of Palmyra Township asking that Joseph Chamberlain be appointed constable in said Township to fill a vacancy. On motion Joseph Chamberlain was appointed a constable in and for said Township to fill vacancy occasioned by the resignation of C. B. Burns.

A proposition was presented by R. P. Duval, McP. Baxter and L. J. Green & purchase of the County all certificates of sale for taxes on lots in Prairie City offering to pay One Dollar and twenty five cents for each lot & include all certificates held by the County also on all lots on which the County has any interest.

On motion the proposition was accepted and the treasurer was authorized to transfer the certificates upon payment of the amount.

The report of the viewers appointed to view the route of a road petitioned for by J. Williams and others was read and on motion the report was adopted and the road established and ordered to be opened for public travel according to the plat and field notes accompanying the report.

The report of Reviewers appointed to review the route of a road which had become uncertain on account of the destruction of the field notes was read and on motion the road was ordered to be re-established in accordance with the report of the viewers (Yes)
