The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to an act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas entitled "an act relating to the Assessment and Collection of taxes in Douglas County" Approved February 26th 1867^{through present} for the purpose of causing all that portion of Douglas County lying North of the Kansas River to be reassessed and the taxes relieved thereon.

Lawrence Kansas March 11th 1867
