

Lawrence Kansas July 1 1867

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to Law Present Commissioners Gleason, Nace and Cutler and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk. Proceeded to examine the returns of the County Africa for 1867.

On motion the sum of \$5.00 per acre was taken from the valuation of 8 acres of land in the N.W. Cor. of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of 11.14-18 and the sum of 50 cents per acre added to the N.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of 2.14.18.

A petition was received and read from Citizens of Grant Township asking that Jesse W. Wright

The Board proceeded to canvass the returns of the annual Township election held on the 25th day of March 1867 - after which adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment Full Board and clerk present.

A petition was presented signed by Wesley Garrett and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing that legal publication and notice of the petition had been made it was ordered that N.D. Readwell, F. F. Bruner and P. G. Weyer be appointed viewers of said proposed road to meet with the County Surveyor at the house of Wesley Garrett on the 27th day of April 1867 at 10 o'clock a.m.

A petition was presented signed by John W. Locher and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal publication had been made it was on motion ordered that Joseph L. Jones, Aaron E. Platts and W. H. D. Wakefield be appointed to view said proposed road to meet for that purpose at the house of John W. Locher on the 2nd day of May 1867 at 10 o'clock a.m.

A petition was presented signed by John F. Buchheim and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing that legal publication had been made it was ordered that Joseph L. Jones, Aaron E. Platts and W. H. D. Wakefield be appointed to meet with the County Surveyor on the 3rd day of May 1867 at 10 o'clock a.m. at the house of John W. Locher for the purpose of viewing said proposed road as required by law.
