

1st 1864 was presented and read recommending that the road be established on motion the report was adopted and it was ordered that the road be established in accordance with the plat and field notes accompanying the report and the clerk was directed to have the proper officers notified to open said road as a public highway. The report of viewers appointed to view a street running East and West on the North side of Babcock's addition to the lots of Lawrence on the petition of C. F. Garrett and others for vacating said street was presented and read and on motion said street was ordered to be vacated from Ohio Street to Kentucky Street and that the clerk be instructed to deed the land so vacated to the person or parties to whom the same may belong as required by law.

The Report of the viewers appointed on the petition of G. W. Godwin and others for a road filed in the clerk's office December 27th 1867 was read and on motion the report was rejected on account of illegality of the action of the viewers.

The annual Report of J. T. Starr Trustee of Palmyra Township of the receipts and expenditures of said Township for the year ending March 25 1867 was presented examined and approved. The bill of J. T. Starr for services as Trustee of Palmyra Township for said year was examined and approved.

On motion the sum of \$196.61 was appropriated for the support of Poor in Palmyra Township for the year March 25th 1867.

E. D. Houghson presented a Road petition but it appearing that legal notice had not been made he asked leave to withdraw the petition which on motion was granted.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of Tho^s. McWhu and others (petition filed Jan^y 1st 1866) laid over at the January meeting of the Board was taken up and on motion the report was adopted and it was ordered by the Board that the road be established in accordance with the plat and field notes accompanying the report.

On motion the sum of \$80.00 was allowed to Robt Peoples as damages on account of the location of said road.

The Report of the viewers appointed to view the route of a road petitioned for by Robt Peoples and others was taken up and on motion rejected.

On motion the clerk was instructed to make a correction in the tax of Jonathan Weaver of Soudora Township he having been assessed in the Corporation of Soudora and erroneously assessed otherwise.

A petition was presented signed by P. W. Bote and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made it was on motion ordered that J. M. Willey James Whaley and J. W. Hogue be appointed viewers of said proposed road to meet with the County Surveyor at the house of P. W. Bote on the 9th day of May ad 1867 at ten o'clock a.m.

On motion the sum of \$40.25 was ordered to be refunded to Geo E. Weaver he having proved to the satisfaction of the Board that he had paid that amount on United States Bonds listed as personal property.

On motion the Board adjourned until tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock.
