

Wednesday April 3 1867

The Board met pursuant to adjournment Full Board and clerk present

The report of the viewers of a road petitioned for by J. P. Whitney and others (Petition filed November 30 1866) was presented and read recommending that the road be established and opened. on motion the report was adopted and the road established in accordance with the plat and field notes accompanying the report.

A petition was presented and read signed by Philip Metcalf and others asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made it was on motion ordered that John Howard J. H. Kelly and James Barst be appointed viewers of said proposed road and that they be notified to meet with the County Surveyor at the house of Philip Metcalf on the 16th day of May 1867 at ten o'clock a.m.

The report of a majority of the viewers appointed on the petition of Eben Poole and others (Petition filed Dec. 31 1866) for the vacation of a portion of the Lawrence and Marion road (so called) was presented and read a report was also read signed by E. H. Vanhosen one of the viewers. On motion the majority report was adopted and it was ordered that the road be vacated according to the plat and field notes forming a part of said report.

The annual report of William Crutchfield Trustee of Nassau Township was presented examined and approved also the bill of said Trustee for services for the year ending April 3 1867 was examined and approved.

A petition was presented signed by C. H. Sears and others asking that a road be located from Eudora to Baldwin's lity and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice had been given it was on motion ordered that Charles Dickens W. B. Kennedy and Wm. McCain be appointed to view the route of said proposed road and it was further ordered that they be notified to meet with the County Surveyor at the Store of Pilla Brothers in the Town of Eudora on the 23rd day of May 1867 at 10 o'clock a.m. for the purpose of surveying said road as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by Samuel Jones and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that J. T. Starr Thomas Chapman and Josiah McQuinn be appointed to meet with the County Surveyor on the 22nd day of April 1867 at 10 o'clock a.m. at the house of F. B. Varnum.

A petition was presented signed by Jacob Mybright and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication of said petition had been made it was ordered that Michael Rothrock Geo. McCain and Anthony Kelly be appointed viewers and that they be notified to meet at the house of E. H. Vanhosen at Mellow Springs on the 6th day of January 1867 at 10 o'clock a.m. A petition was presented signed by F. Fuller and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had
