On motion the sum of \$906.00 was abated from the amount of personal property assessed to J. C. Vincent of Hamwaka Township he having presented satisfactory proof that the same was erroneously assessed.

Seventeen coupons of the Bonds of the Loan of 1859 amounting to \$85.00 a list of which find herewith marked "B" County School orders to the amount of \$1034.47 a list of which find herewith marked "C". Your committee have carefully examined compared and cancelled the same as required by law after which they were destroyed by burning
