Lawrence Kans July 1 1867

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to law there were present F. Glasgow Chairman Wm Mc Kae and Geo Cutler and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The board proceeded to examine the returns of the County Assessor and his deputies for the year 1867

On motion the sum of \$5.00 per acre was deducted from the valuation of 8 acres in the N.W. Cor. of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 11 T. 14 R. 15 - and the sum of fifty cents per acre added to the N.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 2 T. 14 R. 15 in Marion Township.

A petition was presented from citizens of Grant Township asking that Jesse W. Wright be appointed to fill a vacancy existing in the office of Constable in said Township on motion he was appointed.

Ordered that \$1000 per acre be deducted from the valuation of the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 25 T. 14 R. 15. and that 50 cents per acre be added to the valuation of Sec. 23 T. 14 R. 15.

Ordered that \$5000 be deducted from the valuation of the S. 1/2 and 23 1/2 feet by 25 feet off E. end of N.W. 1/4 of N. 46 Mass. Street in the City of Lawrence and that \$200. be added to the N.W. 1/4 less 23 feet off East end of 46 Mass St. and that \$300. be added to the N.W. 1/4 of Lot 26 1/2 44 Mass. St Lawrence Kansas.

On motion the Board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock
