The viewers appointed on the road petition of P. H. Rote and others presented a report recommending that the road be located. On motion the road was established in accordance with the field notes and plat accompanying the report.

The viewers appointed on the road petition of John W. Lohr and others presented their report recommending that the petition be granted. On motion it was ordered that the road be established in accordance with the plat and field notes accompanying said report.

The report of Reviewers appointed to review the route of a road commencing at the North East corner of Section 24 Town 14 Range 18 in Marion Township, the route of which had become uncertain on account of the destruction of monuments and marks. On motion the road was reestablished in accordance with the report of said reviewers and the plat and field notes accompanying the same.

The viewers appointed on the petition for a road of John F. Buchheiser and others presented a report recommending that the road be established in accordance with the plat and field notes accompanying. On motion the report was adopted and the road established.

The viewers appointed on the Road petition of Jacob Wraybright and others presented their report recommending that the road be established in accordance with the plat and field notes of the Surveyor accompanying. On motion the report was adopted and the road established.

J. W. Vaughn presented his resignation as Justice of the Peace in and for Palmyra Township which on motion was accepted.

On motion ordered that the sum of \$500. be abated from the assessment of the North half of 76° 24 Massachusetts Street Lawrence Kansas and that the sum of \$1900. be abated from the valuation of Personal Property to Haskell Brothers in the City of Lawrence.
