

The viewers appointed on the petition of F Fuller and others for vacating a road and for the location of a road presented their report which recommended that the petition be not granted. On motion the report was adopted and the clerk directed to collect the costs of the principal petitioners.

On motion ordered that \$100. be taken from the valuation of Number 20 Ohio Street in the City of Lawrence and added to the valuation of 15 Ohio Street.

On motion ordered that that the valuation of the Lawrence Bridge be raised from fifty thousand Dollars to ^{five} fifty thousand Dollars.

The Bond of S. W. Walker Justice of the Peace was presented for approval which was not approved on account of insufficiency of security.

Bond of S. B. Waters appointed a Justice of the Peace to fill a vacancy in Palmyra Township presented and approved.

Bill of R. F. Barber for one quarters salary Superintendent of the County Asylum \$250. allowed.

Bill of Robt. Wilson setting hedge on Poor farm \$260 allowed.

The viewers appointed on the petition for a road of Emuall Jones presented a report recommending that the road be established in part to wit from the North line of Palmyra Township to the quarter section corner between Sections 22. & 27 Town 13 S. Range 20 East.

Claims for damages laid over until the next meeting of the Board.

On motion the Board ordered ~~that the~~ road be established in part as recommended in the report of the viewers.

On motion the Board adjourned until July

Lawrence Kansas July 24 1867

This being the day to which the Board adjourned and no one being present but the chairman and clerk adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.

July 25th 1867 9 o'clock a.m.

The Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment. Present Commissioners Gleason Nace and Cutler and the County Clerk.

The County Treasurer presented his report of receipts and expenditures from August 1st 1866 to July 12 1867 with a statement of the amount of tax certificates and delinquent tax held by the County. On motion the report was referred to the County Clerk to compare with his books and on motion it was ordered that the Clerk be directed to compare said report with his accounts and prepare a statement of the receipts and disbursements of the County for the time embraced in the Treasurers report and also a statement of the Financial Condition of the County on the day of 1867 and cause the same
