Lawrence Kansas October 7 1867

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment Present F. Glasgow Chairman, Wm. W. Kacy and Geo. Leutter Commissioners and the County Clerk -

The County Superintendent of Public Instruction presented the names of Mr. Soule W. E. Barnes and William Sill as appraisers of the East half of Section 16 Town 14 Range 20 the same having been petitioned to be sold as school land, on motion the appointments were approved.

A petition was presented signed by Jacob Markley and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal publication and notice whereupon it was ordered that William P. Ramsey Ben Ulrich and Aaron Corey be appointed viewers of the proposed road with directions to meet with the County Surveyor at the house of Jacob Markley on the 31st day of October at 10 o'clock A.M. 1868.

On motion it was ordered that propositions be submitted to the qualified electors of Douglas County to appropriate the sum of Twenty Three Thousand Dollars for the purpose of building a bridge at Hutchinsons Crossing, the Superstructure of a bridge at Audora and the Superstructure of a bridge at Gates crossing and a bridge across Mud Creek on the Lawrence and LeCompton Road, and the Clerk was instructed to publish notice of the same as required by law.
