

A report was presented and read from the viewers appointed on the road petition of John A. Kelley and others. On motion the report was adopted and it was ordered that the road be established as shown by the plat and field notes accompanying said report.

A report was presented and read from the viewers appointed on the petition of R. H. Puck and others for a road. On motion the report was adopted and it was ordered that the road be established as shown by the plat and field notes of the County Surveyor accompanying the report.

A report was presented and read from the viewers appointed on the petition of O. R. Stitt and others. On motion the report was adopted and it was further ordered that the road be established in accordance with the field notes and plat accompanying the report.

A report was presented and read from viewers appointed on the petition of J. F. Francett and others. On motion the report was adopted and it was ordered that the road be established in accordance with the Plat and field notes accompanying the same.

The report of Commissioners appointed to locate a State road from Lawrence to the North line of Bourbon County which was referred to L. F. Carver Surveyor for correction having been returned with corrections and was taken up and on motion the Clerk was instructed to record the portion running through Douglas County in the road book.

A petition was presented and read signed by J. H. Harrison and others asking that the road running from Lawrence to Leecompton known as the middle road be reviewed and reestablished remarking that the route of said road had become uncertain on account of the destruction of the field notes. On motion it was ordered that Turner Sampson D. T. Mitchell and Ruben Randall be appointed Reviewers of said road and the Clerk was instructed to notify said reviewers to meet with the County Surveyor at the living stable of Sampson and Walker in the City of Lawrence on the 25th day of November 1867 for the purpose of reviewing said road.

A petition was presented signed by Herman Torow and a legal number of Petitioners asking that a change be made in the Lawrence and Leecompton road with proof of legal publication whereupon it was ordered that Turner Sampson D. T. Mitchell and Ruben Randall be appointed Reviewers of said road and the change petitioned for with instructions to meet with the County Surveyor on the 25th day of November AD 1867 at 10 o'clock a.m.

A petition was presented signed by T. B. Smith and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal publication and notice whereupon it was ordered that R. L. Jackson R. L. Williams and H. F. Bisell be appointed to view the route of said proposed road & meet for that purpose with the County Surveyor at the house of T. B. Smith on the 25th day of November AD. One thousand Eight hundred and sixty seven at ten o'clock a.m.
