

Lawrence Kansas October 10 1867

The Board met pursuant to adjournment. Full Board and Clerk present.

A petition was presented signed by B. Wright and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication. Whereupon it was ordered that Com^{rs} H. Christian James Beach and William Brass be appointed viewers of said proposed road to meet with the County Surveyor at the house of Com^r Garrett on the 3^d day of December AD 1867 at ten O'clock AM.

A petition was presented signed by H. B. Lacy and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal publication. Whereupon on motion it was ordered that Wm^{rs} Sedgewick J. C. Vincent and Gilbert Griswold be appointed viewers of said proposed road to meet at the house of H. B. Lacy on the 29th day of November AD 1867.

M. A. O'Neil presented a petition asking that the streets and alleys in the town of Black Jack be vacated and it appearing from the affidavit of the Petitioner that a majority of all the lots in said town belonged to him it was thereupon ordered that the Clerk be instructed to advertise as required by law that such application has been made to the Board of Commissioners and that on the first Monday in January AD 1868 they will take testimony regarding the occupancy of said town site.
