

met on the 30th day of January A.D. 1868 at 10 o'clock A.M. at the house of Thomas M. Pearson and view said road as required by law.

On motion it was ordered that Eben Crutchfield Esq Trustee of Wakarusa Township be appointed a Commissioner to examine and report to the board an estimate of the expense of building a bridge across Mud Creek on the Decongeston Middle road in said Township bridge to have stone abutments and superstructure to be of pine.

Wm Crutchfield Trustee of Wakarusa Township presented vouchers for the expenditure of funds collected by him on a subscription list turned over to him to be applied in repairing the Stewart Crossing road. On motion the vouchers were accepted and the Clerk was instructed to deliver the receipt taken for said subscription list to Mr Crutchfield. A petition was presented signed by C. H. Taylor and others for a road. On motion it was rejected.

A petition was presented and read signed by Thomas Garnold and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication. Whereupon it was ordered that E. Disbrow J. C. Steele and E. L. Macy viewers of said proposed road and it was further ordered that said viewers and the County Surveyor meet on the 13th day of February A.D. 1868 at ten o'clock A.M. at the house of Thomas Garnold and view and survey said road as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by Martin Sedgewick and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication. Whereupon it was ordered that William Crutchfield E. P. Briggs and G. W. Goss be appointed viewers of said proposed road and it was further ordered that said viewers and the County Surveyor meet on the 20th day of February at 10 o'clock A.M. at the house of Martin Sedgewick and view and survey said road as required by law.

The report of the viewers appointed upon the petition of Jacob Markley and others for a road having been filed as required by law was presented and read and no legal objections being made thereto, the Board being satisfied that the road will be of public utility and the report of the viewers being favorable thereto it was ordered that the Report plat and survey be recorded and it was further ordered that the Clerk issue the Order of the Board to the proper Overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of Charles W. Hughes and others for a road having been filed as required by law was presented and read and no legal objections being made thereto the Commissioner being satisfied that the road will be of public utility, the report of the viewers
