The Reviewers appointed by the Board to review and relocate the Beacompton Middle road so called leading from Lawrence to Beacompton having filed their report in the Clerk's office as required by law it was presented and read, no legal objections being made thereto it was on motion ordered that the report plat and survey be recorded.

On motion the board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.
