The Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment

and Geo. Butler. and the County Clerk.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of T. B. Smith and others for a road was taken up and read and the report of the viewers being objected to on account of one of the viewers having claimed damages. On motion it was ordered that the report of the viewers be referred to the County Attorney for his opinion as to its legality.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of J. S. Jones and others for a road was presented and read and on motion the report was rejected on account of illegality.

In the matter of the petition of H. B. Lacy and others for a road the report of the viewers having been filed it was read and it appearing that only two of the viewers appointed were sworn the report was rejected.

In the matter of the petition of Wesley Garrett and others for a road the viewers having filed a report it was read and it appearing that but two viewers were sworn it was ordered by the Board that the report be rejected.

In the matter of the petition of C. H. Taylor and others for a road. The Commissioners being satisfied that legal notice and publication had been made. It was ordered by the Board that F. F. Bruner Thomas Sexton and G. W. Goss be appointed viewers and it was further ordered that the Clerk issue the order of the Board to said viewers and the County Surveyor to meet at the house of C. H. Taylor on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law.
