Lawrence Kansas January 13 1868

Pursuant to call of J. H. E. Griffith and Geo. Lutter two of the commissioners elect of Douglas County, The Board of Commissioners of said County met at the office of the County Clerk there were present Commissioners Griffith, Lutter and Aaron E. Platts who having taken and filed the oath of office required by law proceeded to elect a chairman of the Board. A ballot was taken with the following result Geo. Lutter received two votes and Aaron E. Platts received one vote George Lutter was declared elected Chairman of the Board.

The petition of H. A. O'Neill for vacating streets and alleys in the town of Black Jack was taken up and several parties were heard in regard to the occupancy of the town site. On motion the matter was laid over until the April meeting of the Board.

The Bond of J. T. Starr County Assessor was presented examined and approved. Henry Joy of Eudora Township presented an application for aid in supporting a cripple lying at his house. On motion the application was referred to the Trustee of Eudora Township with the request that he report the amount in his opinion necessary for the support of said cripple.

The County Assessor presented the names of E. D. Ladd and H. H. Williams as Deputy County Assessors, on motion the appointments were approved.

On motion T. Fuller and Holland Chiles County Surveyors were appointed to examine the superstructure and approaches to Hutchinson's crossing bridge built by Lescher and Hollville and report to the Board whether said superstructure and approaches are constructed in accordance with the contract made between the County and said Lescher and Hollville.

On motion the Board adjourned until Thursday next at 9 o'clock a.m.
