The Board proceeded to examine bids for Superintending the county Asylum for the ensuing year and the board having determined that James Wallace was the lowest and best bidder on motion it was ordered that he be appointed Superintendent of the County Asylum and farm for one year from the first day of March 1868 at a salary of \$700.

Levi C. Put a resident of School District No 40 filed an appeal from the decision of the County Superintendent in refusing to enlarge said District. On motion the Clerk was instructed to notify the County Superintendent that the appeal of Mr Put had been made and that the ~~case~~ matter could be taken up for consideration and decision on Tuesday the 11th day of February 1868.

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Tuesday February 11th 1868

The Board met pursuant to adjournment Present Commissioners better Griffith and Platts and the County Clerk. A petition was presented signed by R. Hitchcock and others setting forth that the route of a road commencing at the North East corner of Section 8 Township 15 Range 20 running thence South has become uncertain on account of the destruction of the field notes and asking that the same be reviewed and reestablished. On motion it was ordered that A. B. Gilliland, W. B. Hayden & Co. be appointed reviewers of said road and the Clerk was directed to issue the order of the Board to said reviewers and the County Surveyor directing them to meet on the 4th day of March 1868 at the house of R. Hitchcock and review relocate and survey the route of said road as required by law.

On motion the Chairman of the Board and the County Clerk were appointed a committee to receive from the County Treasurer such County warrants bonds and coupons and other vouchers which he may wish to turn over to the board cancel and list the same as required by law and report to the board at their April meeting. It was further ordered that the same committee be authorized and instructed to receive the report of the committee
