to the South East corner of Section 10 same Township and range Thence North
one half mile thence East one half mile thence South one half mile
thence East one half mile Thence North one mile Thence West one
half mile Thence North one and a half miles Thence West one half
mile Thence North one half mile Thence East one half mile. Thence
North one half mile to the place of beginning.

by the viewers.
