William McKinney presented petition for license to keep a on the Hannas River at the town of Lecompton. It appearing that such ferry was necessary for the accommodation of the public. It was ordered that the clerk issue a license to the said Wm McKinney for the term of one year from the first of April 1868 when he shall have paid a tax of fifteen Dollars into the County Treasury and presented a receipt therefor.

A petition was presented and read signed by Geo. C. Brooks and others asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that James H. Byrson Charles Barber and James Whaley be appointed Viewers of said proposed road and it was further ordered that the clerk be directed to issue the Order of the Board to said Viewers and the County Surveyor to meet at the house of Geo. C. Brooks on the 15th day of May 1868 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law.

A petition was presented and read signed by R. C. Tasker and others asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made. It was ordered that W. G. Wellsville T. J. Starnbergh and J. H. Ewing be appointed Viewers of said proposed road and it was further ordered that the clerk issue the order of the Board to said Viewers and the County Surveyor to meet at the house of R. C. Tasker on the 5th day of May A.D. 1868 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view locate
