The report of the Viewers appointed on the petition of Thomas M. Piersow and others for a road having been filed in the Clerk's Office was taken up and read the report being favorable to the establishment of the road and no legal objections being made thereto the Commissioners being satisfied that the road will be of public utility it was ordered that the report filed and survey be recorded and that the Clerk issue the order of the Board to the proper Overseer of roads to open the same for public travel.

A petition was presented and read signed by William Hughes and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made and William Hughes one of the petitioners having filed his bond with approved security conditioned for the payment of all costs accruing, provided the road shall not be established it was ordered that O. E. Searnard J. S. Guigerich and H. L. Enos be appointed Viewers of said proposed road and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and it was further ordered that the Clerk issue the order of the Board to said Viewers and Surveyor to meet at the house of William Hughes on the 19th day of May A.D. 1868 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law.

The report of the Viewers appointed on the petition of L. J. Chastani and others was taken up and read and such report being unfavorable to the establishment of the road, on motion the petition was rejected.

A petition was presented and read signed by A. G. Grew and a legal number of petitioners asking that certain roads described therein be vacated and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that William Parker Robert Young and William S. James be appointed Viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of the roads proposed to be vacated and the Clerk was directed to issue the order of the Board to said Viewers and Surveyor to meet at the house of A. G. Grew June 2 1868 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view and survey the route of the roads proposed to be vacated as required by law.

A petition was presented and read signed by William Alenboud and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that O. E. Searnard J. S. Guigerich and H. L. Enos be appointed Viewers of such proposed road and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and it was further ordered that the Clerk issue the order of the Board to said Viewers and Surveyor to meet at the house of William Hughes on the 19th day of May A.D. 1868 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view
