The proposition is as follows

"Office of Kansas Tribune

Lawrence Kansas April 6 1868

To the Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas  
Gentlemen

As my proposition for reducing the taxes of the people has worked admirably thus far I propose to continue the county printing on the same terms for the six months ensuing the first day of May 1868. I will do without charge for either printing or advertising for the time specified all of which is respectfully submitted

John Spur"

Mr Griffith presented the following resolution. Resolved that the Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to borrow money on the best terms possible not exceeding five per cent additional rate of interest to pay the balance due for building the bridges authorized by the county commissioners and repay the same out of the first money which may come into his hands for county purposes. On motion the resolution was adopted.
