

April 8 1868

The Board met pursuant to adjournment Full board present.

In the matter of the petitions for Review of Roads by William B. Barker and by Jesse McKinney and others on account of the opinion of the County Attorney that legal notice and publication was required as in the case of new roads such petitions were rejected.

A petition was presented signed by J. L. Jones and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that John Kelley, M. S. Weathers and Benjamin Storey be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of such proposed road and it was further ordered that said viewers and surveyor meet at the house of J. L. Jones on the 5th day of June 1868 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law. and the clerk was instructed to issue the order of the Board.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of P. Elbright and others was taken up and read and on motion the report was referred to the County Attorney for his opinion in relation to legal points involved therein.

A petition was presented signed by Nicholas Weil and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at points named therein and for a change in a road described in said petition and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that Thomas Warren Thomas Pinson and Arthur Basil be appointed viewers of such proposed road and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and it was further ordered that said viewers and surveyor meet at the house of Nicholas Weil on the 9th day of June next or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law.

William Crutchfield presented his report as Trustee of Watkinesa Township of the receipts and expenditures of said Township for the year ending April 4 1868 with vouchers. The report was examined and approved. The bill of William Crutchfield for services as Trustee of said township was examined and approved.

E. H. Vanhousen Trustee of Willow Springs Township presented his report of receipts and expenditures for the current year which was examined and approved. Bill for services of E. H. Vanhousen as Trustee for the same time approved.

The Board adjourned until ten o'clock P. M.
