A petition was presented and read signed by Thomas R. Mills and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be located and established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that legal notice and publication had been made and bond filed as required by law it was ordered that William Means J. W. Goss and Henry Brown be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of such proposed road and it was further ordered that the clerk issue the order of the board to said viewers and surveyor to meet at the house of W. J. Downing on the 2^d day of May next or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and view locate and survey such proposed road as required by law.

Mr. Griffith introduced the following resolution which on motion was adopted.

Resolved that the attorney heretofore employed to defend the county against the suits of the Union Pacific Railway Company for a perpetual injunction against the county Treasurer for collecting the taxes due the county be requested and instructed to use all diligence in their power in defending said suits and to obtain a decision dismissing the same at the earliest possible moment so that the legal and just taxes due Douglas County may be collected without hindrance.
