Friday July 10 ad 1868

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment. They were present Commissioner Luther, Griffith and Platt, and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had. A petition was presented signed by David Stern and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication. On motion it was ordered that William Danicklow, J. F. Starr and H. L. Leradit be appointed to view the route of said proposed road and that the Clerk be directed to issue the order of the Board to said viewers directing them to meet with the County Surveyor on the 25th day of August ad 1868 at ten o'clock A.M. at the house of David Sterns for the purposes named in said Order.

A petition was presented signed by E. R. Griffith and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the board that legal notice and publication had been made and security for carts given provided the road shall not be established as prayed for. On motion it was ordered that Wm. H. Gill, John Faust and C. H. Marcy be appointed viewers and Holland Whales Surveyor of the proposed road and it was further ordered that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the Pearson School house on the first day of September ad 1868 and view locate and survey said proposed road.

A petition was presented signed by T. J. Riling and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that legal notice and publication had been made and security given for carts in case the prayer of the petitioners is not granted. It was on motion ordered that Samuel Black, J. F. Starr and William McElrury be appointed viewers and Holland Whales Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor be directed to meet at the house of T. J. Riling on the 8th day of September ad 1868 and view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by John Oxilivare and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that legal notice and publication had been made and security given for carts in case the prayer of the petitioners shall not be granted.
