McMillan and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication and bond as required by law Whereupon it was ordered that William Comutchfield Joel Brooks and William Means be appointed viewers and Holland Whelby Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of August ad 1868 at the house of F. Eggert and view locate and Survey said proposed road as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by R. Preston and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication, and Bond filed as required by law Whereupon it was ordered that Wm. B. Hayden John Edie and Samuel Spence be appointed viewers and Holland Whelby Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September ad 1868 at the house of R. Preston and view locate and Survey said road as required by law.
