The report of Robert Young Census of Poor Exemption Township for the year ending July 1 1868 was read and approved.

The following resolution was offered and adopted

Whereas the County stands in much need of better accommodations in the way of public buildings for Court room County Offices &c. and whereas the City of Lawrence by its Mayor and City Council propose to erect a building suitable for the purpose Therefore resolved by this Board and it is hereby agreed that in case the said City of Lawrence shall erect such suitable building that the County of Douglas by its Commissioners will hire or lease said rooms for the term of ten years at such reasonable compensation as may be agreed upon.

Robert Gardner presented a petition setting forth that Lot No 118 Kentucky Street in the City of Lawrence was illegally assessed for the year 1863 it then belonging to a religious Society On motion it was ordered that the Treasurer be authorized to cancel the sale of said lot for the taxes of 1863.
