The Board being satisfied that a majority of the qualified electors of said Township had signed the petition it was on motion Ordered That all persons owning horses or neat cattle in Clinton Township shall keep the same confined in the night time from the first day of May until the first day of February of each year - a copy of said order was made out and signed by the commissioners and it was ordered that the clerk be instructed to cause the same to be published as required by law.

On motion it was ordered that William Means Trustee of Alabamusa township be appointed a commissioner to advertise for proposals for furnishing materials and building bridges across Mud Creek at Levi Baldwin's in said township also for a bridge at Jones crossing of Coal Creek according to plans and specifications to be furnished by the Board.

A. Stonebraker and others was taken up and on motion laid over until Wednesday Oct. 7 at 11 O'clock A.M.
