The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Butler and Griffith and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

A petition was presented signed by Charles Goodholtz and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication and bond as required by law. On motion it was ordered that Charles H. Sears, John Longor and John E. Campbell be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of the proposed road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 27th day of October A.D. 1868 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter, at the school house in Eudora and proceed to view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law.
