

Pirson and J. W. Williams be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of the proposed road. And that said Viewers and Surveyor meet on the 5th day of November 1868 at the house of J. W. Gleason, or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view locate and survey the road petitioned for as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by W. B. H. Whitney and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication and bond as required by law. Whereupon it was ordered by the Board that Albert G. Brooks C. A. Hanscom be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of the road petitioned for and that said Viewers and Surveyor meet on the third day of November ¹⁸⁶⁸ at the Tall house in North Lawrence, or failing to meet on that day, within five days thereafter, and thence proceed to view locate and survey said proposed road as required by law in such cases made and provided.

A petition was presented signed by Taylor Stephens and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication and bond as required by law. Whereupon it was ordered that L. J. Sperry, William Hughes and Robert Irving be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and that said Viewers and Surveyor meet on the 2^d day of October 1868 at the house of John Gilmore or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view lay out and survey the route of said proposed road as required by law.

The report of the viewers appointed by the Board in their Order of July 10th 1868 on the petition of B. Ruston and others having been filed in the Clerk's Office was presented and read and said report being favorable to the establishment of a portion of the road petitioned for and no legal objections appearing to be made to said report. On motion it was ordered that the road be established in accordance with the report of the viewers and it was further ordered that the report plat and survey be recorded in the road record, and that the Clerk be directed to issue the Order of the Board to the proper Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The report of viewers appointed under the Order of the Board made April 6 1868 on the petition of J. A. Stonebraker and others having been filed in the Clerk's Office as required by law was taken up and read, the report appearing to be informal. On motion it was referred to the County Attorney for his opinion as to whether said report conforms to law.

In the matter of the petition of Mrs. R. Wells and others for a road to be established, The report of the viewers, filed July 1 1868 and laid over at the July session of the Board until October session was taken up.
