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the report plat and survey be recorded and that the clerk issue the Order of the Board to the proper Overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The report of the Viewers appointed under the order of the Board made July 10 1868 on the petition of John O'Sullivan and others having been filed in the Clerk's office as required by law it was read and being favorable to the establishment of the road and no legal objection being made thereto it was ordered by the Board that the report plat and survey be recorded and the clerk was directed to issue the order of the Board to the proper Overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The report of the Viewers appointed under the order of the Board made July 10 1868, on the petition of J. P. Riling and others having been filed in the Clerk's office as required by law it was read and being favorable to the establishment of the road and no legal objections being made thereto it was on motion ordered that the report plat and survey be recorded and that the clerk be instructed to issue the Order of the Board to the proper Overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The report of the Viewers appointed by the Board in their Order of July 10 1868 on the petition of David Kerns and others for the vacation of a road having been filed in the Clerk's office as required by law it was read and being favorable to the vacation of the road and no legal objection being made thereto it was ordered by the Board that the report plat and survey be recorded and that said road be vacated.

The report of the Viewers appointed by the board in their order of July 10 1868 on the petition of E. R. Griffith and others for a road was taken up and read the same having been filed in the Clerk's office as required by law the report being favorable to the establishment of the road no legal objections being made thereto it was ordered that the report plat and survey be recorded and the clerk was directed to issue the Order of the board to the proper Overseer of roads to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition of B. Wright and others for a road - The county attorney having decided that the report of the viewers was illegal it was on motion ordered that the report be rejected and the case dismissed.

The report of Viewers appointed by the board in their order of July 10 1868, ^{on the petition of D. W. MacMillan and others} having been filed in the Clerk's office as required by law it was presented and read a remonstrance against the establishment of said road having been filed was also read. On motion the report was laid over temporarily.

A petition was presented signed by J. S. Dobbin and a legal number of petitioners asking that a road
