It was thereupon Ordered that O. W. Platt, William Watt and Norman Chambers be appointed viewers of the proposed road and Holland Whelan Surveyor and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 12th day of November 1868 at the house of J. J. Dobbins or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view lay out and survey said road as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by Samuel Buchheim and others asking that a road be established at certain points named therein with proof of legal notice and publication, and Samuel Buchheim one of the petitioners having filed a bond with approved security conditioned for the payment of all costs accruing on the viewing and location of said road in case the same shall not be established. It was Ordered that N. J. Stephens Thomas M. Pinson be appointed viewers and Holland Whelan Surveyor and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 6th day of November 1868 at the house of Samuel Buchheim or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view locate and survey said road as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by Augustus H. Gleason and others asking that a road be established at certain points therein named, with proof of legal notice and publication, and A. H. Gleason one of the petitioners having filed his bond with approved security conditioned for the payment of all costs of view and survey in case the road shall not be established as petitioned for. Thereupon it was ordered that N. J. Stephens, Thomas M. Pinson and J. W. Williams be appointed viewers and Holland Whelan Surveyor of the proposed road and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 5th day of November ad 1868 at the house of A. H. Gleason, or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view lay out and survey said proposed road as required by law.
