

Lawrence Kansas Nov. 14 1868

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to call of the chairman. There were present Commissioners Luther Griffith and Platts and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following resolution was offered read and adopted.

Whereas the Board of Commissioners did at their meeting on the 6th day of November AD 1868 resolve to issue in subscription of stocks to the Leavenworth Lawrence and Galveston Railroad Company Bonds to the amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars in sums of One Thousand Dollars each with coupons attached and Whereas said bonds have not been delivered as contemplated in said resolution therefore be it resolved that instead thereof the Board of County Commissioners issue to said Railroad Company its bond in the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars payable in thirty years from the first day of January 1868 at the office of the County Treasurer of Douglas County with interest payable annually at the rate of seven percent said bond to have interest coupons attached for the annual interest on said bonds and be it further resolved that the Board of County Commissioners reserve the right to exchange the said Three Hundred Thousand Dollar bond and issue in lieu thereof Bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars each with interest coupons attached and the Chairman of the Board be authorized to deliver said bond to said Railroad Company or their agent in accordance with the terms and conditions of the resolutions of this Board passed November 6th 1868, and be it further resolved that the said bond for Three Hundred Thousand Dollars be signed by the Commissioners of said Douglas County and sealed with the seal of said County and that the coupons be signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners.

The Board adjourned
