The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment. Those were present Commissioners Luther Griffith and Platts and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk

The following proceedings were had

A petition was presented from the Superintendent of the County Asylum which was read accepted and ordered to be placed on file.

The report of the Reviewers appointed on the petition of Bethuel Hitchcock and others having been laid over temporarily was taken up and it appearing to the board that the proceedings were illegal it was on motion ordered that the report and petition be rejected.

A proposition was laid before the Board signed by Joseph Chamberlain proposing to purchase the certificates of sale for taxes and all claims for taxes held by the County on all lots in Blocks 62, 63, 64, 49, 50 and 51 in the town of Palmyra and offering to pay at the rate of 12¹/₂ per cent for all such certificates and claims

On motion the proposition was accepted with the proviso that Mr Chamberlain pays all expense of assignment and deeds
