

Lawrence Kansas January 6 1869
The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant
to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Lutter Giff-
fith and Platts.

The following proceedings were had - The report of the
viewers appointed on the petition of A. S. Dotkins and others having been
filed in the Clerk's office as required by law was presented and read
no legal objections being made thereto and the report being favorable to
the establishment of the road it was on motion Ordered that the
Report, survey and plat be recorded and that said road be declared
established. and it was further ordered that the clerk issue the
Order of the Board to the proper Owners of roads to cause said
road to be opened for public travel. The claim for damages of John
Gilmore was considered and rejected.

The report of the viewers ap-
pointed on the petition of S. Astor brakes and others having been filed
in the Clerk's office as required by law was read and it appearing
to the Board that there were informalities in the report it was or-
dered that the report be referred back to the viewers for correc-
tion and it was further ordered that the Clerk notify the viewers
of the action of the Board.

The report of the viewers appointed on the
petition of Chat Goodhally and others having been filed in the Clerk's
office it was read and being favorable to the establishment of
the road and no legal objections being made thereto it was on
motion Ordered that the report, survey and plat be recorded
and that the Clerk issue the Order of the Board to the proper O-
wners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public trav-
el.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of A. H. Guise
and others having been filed in the Clerk's office as required by
law was presented and read. The report of the viewers being favorable
to the establishment of the road and no legal objections being made
thereto it was Ordered by the Board that the report, survey and
plat be recorded and that the clerk be directed to issue the Order
of the Board to the proper Owners of roads to cause said road
to be opened for public travel. The claim for damages of Wm
Mitchell was allowed at \$25.

The report of the viewers appointed
on the petition of J. P. Bond and others for a road having been filed
in the Clerk's office as required by law it was presented and read
no legal objections being made thereto and being favorable to the
establishment of the road it was ordered that the report be
adopted, that the report survey and plat be recorded and
that the Clerk issue the Order of the Board to the proper O-
wners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public
travel.

On motion the board adjourned until
tomorrow morning at nine o'clock
