

Lawrence Kansas January 7 1870

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Cutler Platts and Griffith and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had - Ordered that the County Treasurer be directed to cause the sale for taxes of the following described land to wit: E. 120 acres of of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 33 Town 14. Range 19 said land having been illegally sold.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of Samuel Buchheim and others was presented and read the report being favorable to the establishment of the road and no legal objections being made thereto it was on motion ordered that the report survey and plat be recorded and that the clerk be directed to issue the Order of the Board to the proper owners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel. The claim of Mrs Elizabeth Hately for damages of \$300. was allowed at \$30.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of R. L. Parker and others having been filed in the Clerk's Office as required by law it was presented and read and being favorable to the establishment of the road and no legal objections being made thereto it was on motion ordered that the report survey and plat be recorded and the clerk is hereby directed to issue the Order of the Board to the proper owners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel. The report of the viewers appointed on the petition of Taylor Stevens and others having been filed in the Clerk's Office as required by law, was presented and read, no legal objections being made thereto and being favorable to the establishment of the road, it was Ordered that the report survey and plat be recorded and it was further Ordered that the Clerk be and is hereby directed to cause said road to be opened by issuing the Order of the Board to the proper owners of roads.

The County Clerk delivered to the Board County Orders amounting to \$198.70. which had remained unclaimed for a period of three years a list of which was made and filed in the Clerk's Office the Orders were cancelled on the record and destroyed by burning.

On motion it was ordered that the County Treasurer be instructed to make out certificates from the tax sale record on sales where the certificates have been destroyed and have the same signed.

On motion Dr. M. Bezeley was appointed a constable for the Township of North Lawrence to fill the vacancy occasioned by the removal of F. B. Hill from the township.

On motion the Board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.
